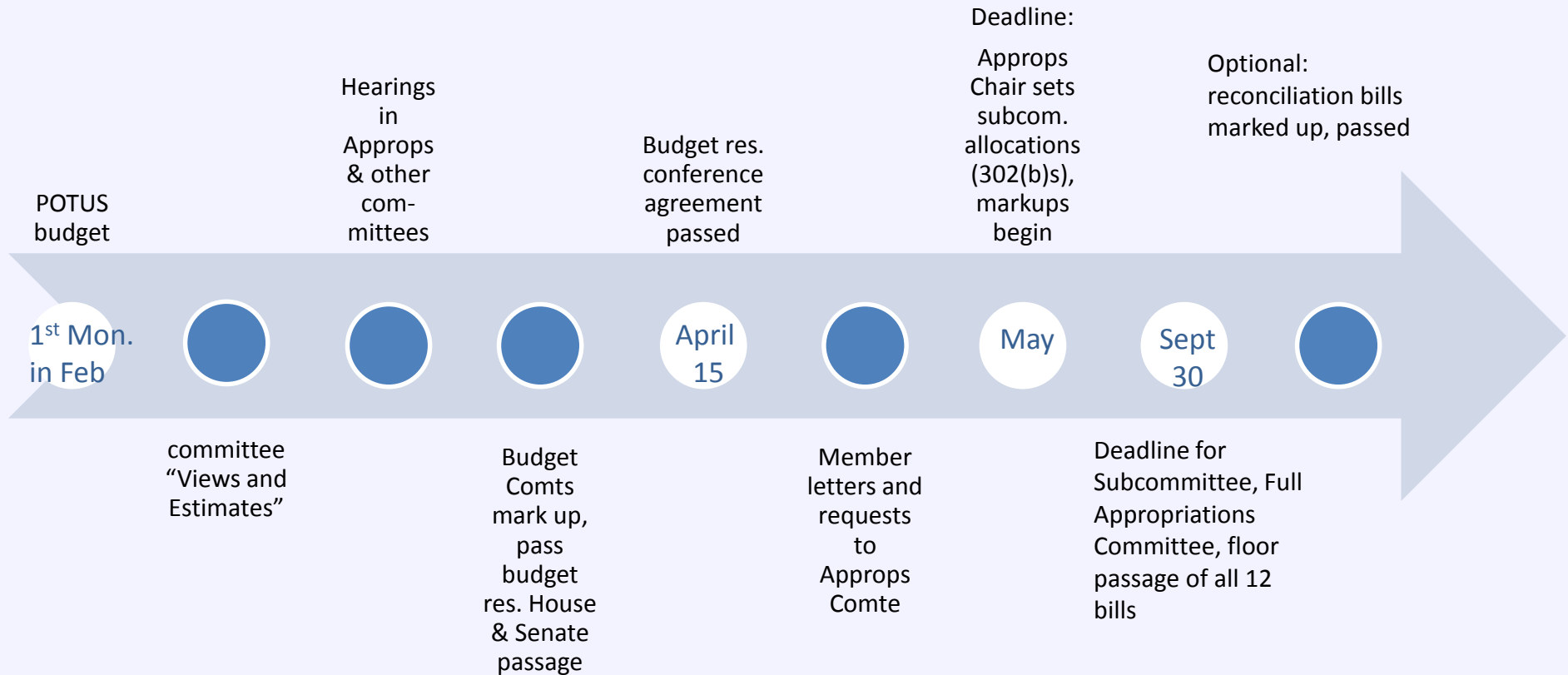

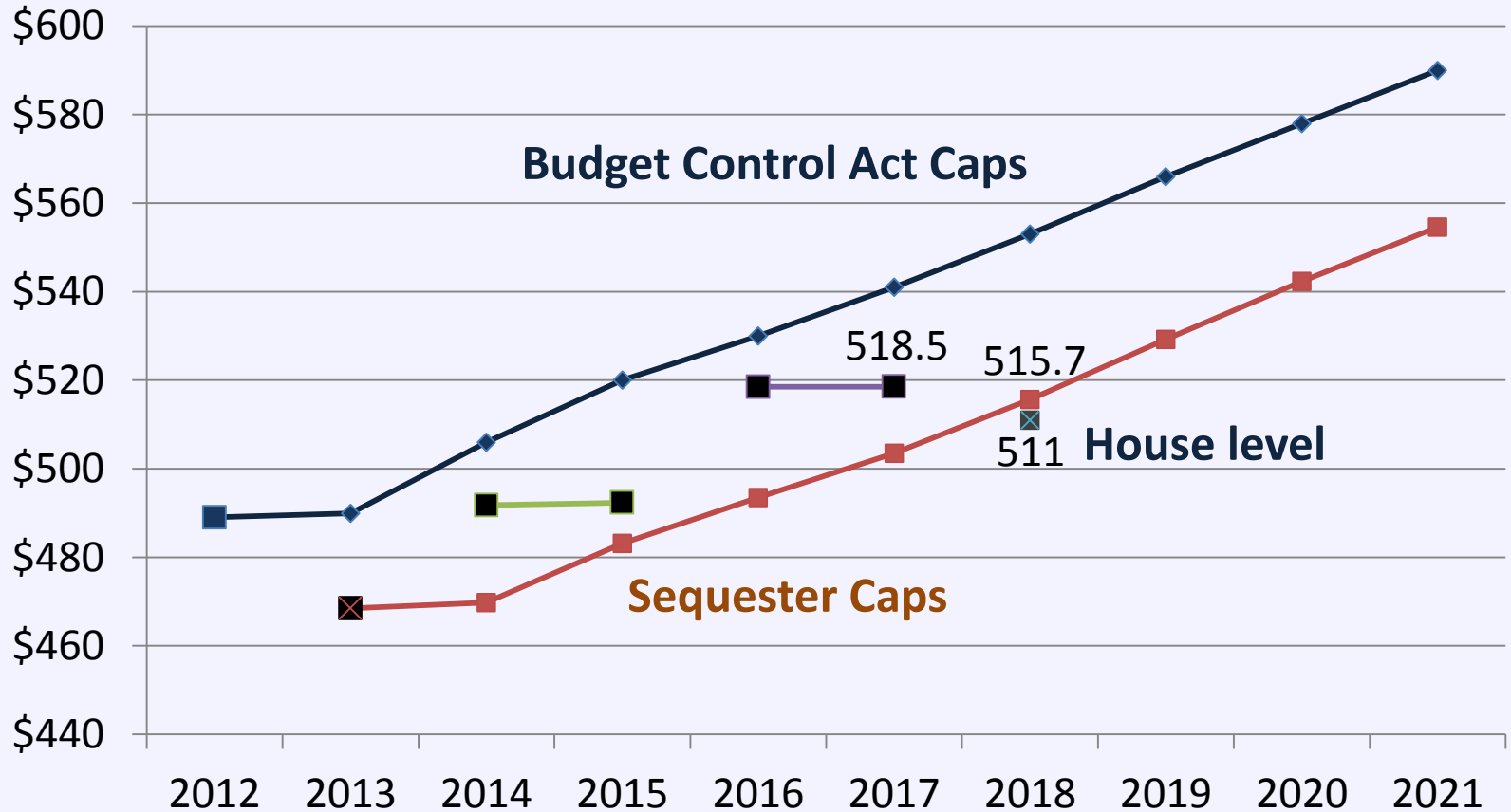

# Education Funding Bill Cut the Most in 2018

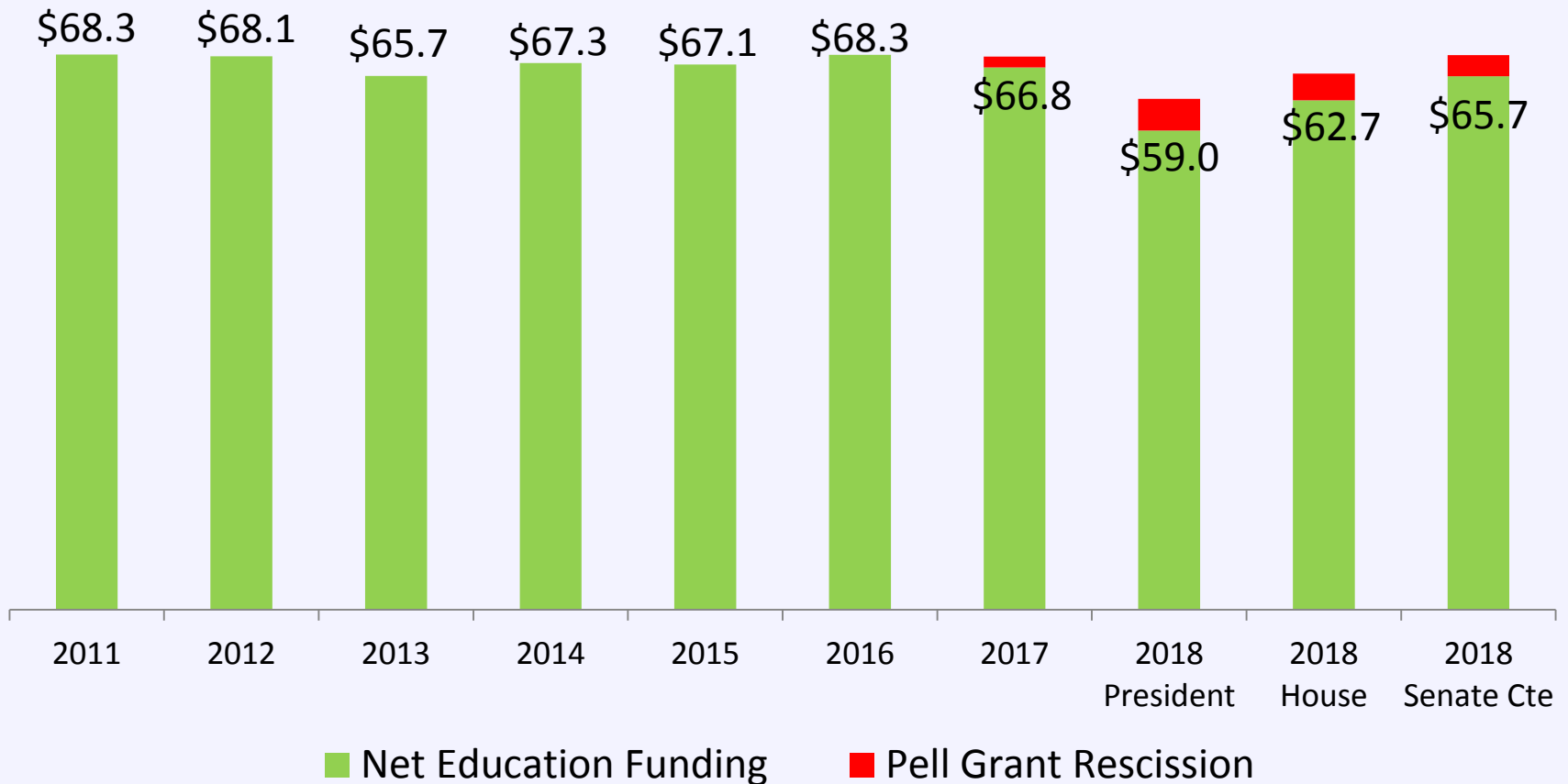
(Change from FY 2017 in nondefense discretionary budget authority in billions, in House bills)



# Rescissions of Pell Grant Funds

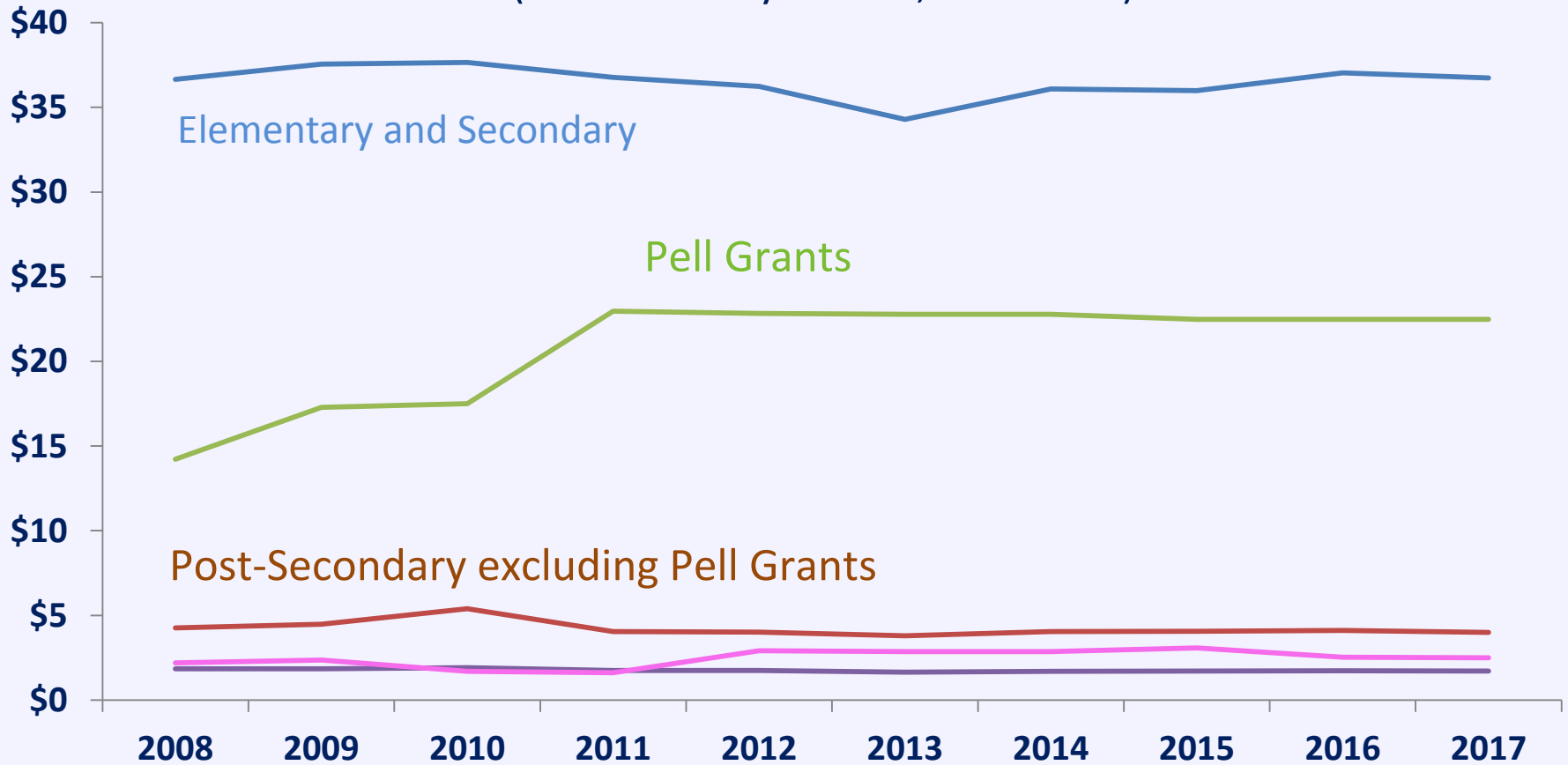
## Further Erode Education Investments

(Discretionary dollars, in billions)

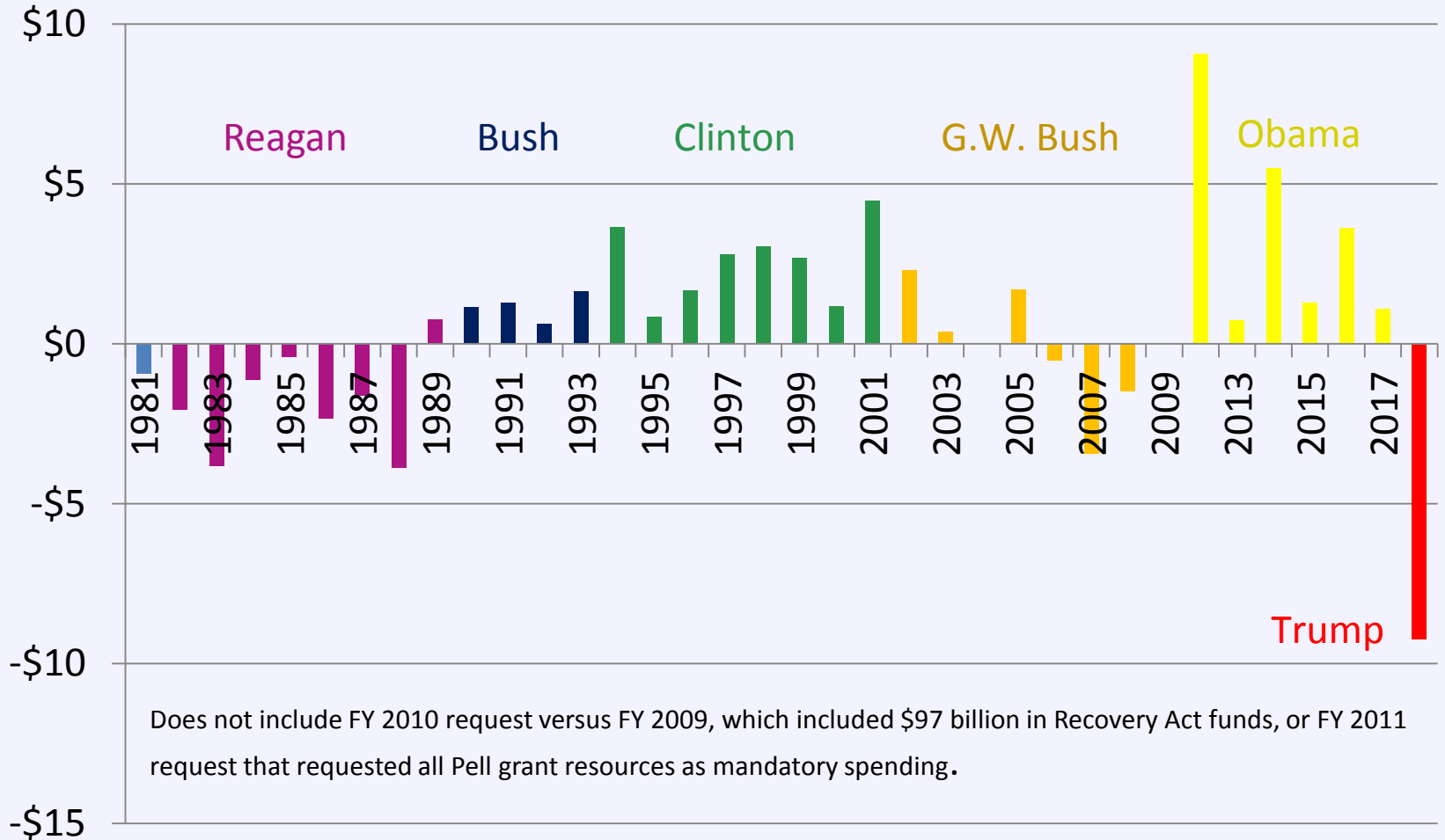
