

THE OESE REORGANIZATION AND ITS IMPACT ON THE MAGNET SCHOOLS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

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WHY IS THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REORGANIZING?

Executive Order 13781, the Comprehensive Plan for Reorganizing the Executive Branch, called for greater efficiency, effectiveness, and accountability in federal agencies; this presented the Department with an opportunity to rethink how we do our work.



WHAT ARE THE GOALS?

- 1. Administer grants in an accurate, timely and thorough manner;
- 2. Build mutually beneficial, resilient and trusting relationships with grantees;
- 3. Improve efficiency, effectiveness and collaboration for internal operations and external stakeholders; and
- 4. Improve dissemination and build capacity related to evidence-based practices.



WHAT OFFICES AND PROGRAMS ARE INVOLVED?

- The full reorganization involves nearly every office within the U.S. Department of Education
- More specifically, all programs previously housed in both OESE and OII—to include MSAP which was previously located in OII.



WHAT WILL THE NEW OESE OFFER?


- Office of State & Grantee Relations: The new Office of State and Grantee Relations will be dedicated to building a stronger, ongoing relationship between grantees and OESE.
- Office of Evidenced-Based Practices: The new Office of Evidence-Based Practices will be dedicated to better integrating the use of evidence into policy, planning, and technical assistance.
- The Office of Formula Grants: This office will continue to support and administer the formula grants under the ESEA.
- Office of Discretionary Grants and Support Services: The Office of Discretionary Grants will support and administer OESE's discretionary grants and technical assistance contracts including nearly all of the discretionary grants and contracts previously housed within Oll.
 - The Magnet Schools Assistance Program is located in this Office, in the School Choice and Improvement Programs Division.
