Entry Requirements:

Districts or schools entering the poster contest must be paid members of MSA for 2019-2020 by November 4, 2019. Please contact the MSA Office at 202-824-0672 OR email membership@magnet.edu for all membership related questions.

NOTE:

- **Institution** members may submit one poster to MSA representing the appropriate level - elementary, middle, or high.
- **District** members may submit **only one poster representing each level** - elementary, middle, and/or high. Schools should coordinate with their appropriate district level department(s).
 - Each district will determine the posters sent to be judged at the national level.
 - Entries will be accepted from the district level completed by individual students only.
 - All entries will become the property of MSA and will not be returned.
 - Each poster must include the official MSA entry form attached to the back of the poster.

Deadline for Submitting Posters:

Please complete the online submission google form and be prepared to upload a digital copy (minimum resolution: 300dpi) of the poster; **AND**

The original poster(s) must be mailed and RECEIVED in the National Office by Tuesday, January 21, 2020 to be eligible. Make sure a copy of the completed form is included with the original poster.

Scoring Rubric:

MSA suggests that school-wide and/or district-wide competitions implement the same scoring rubric for the selection of their winners.

- Adherence to Pillar(s)/Theme(s)
30 points
- Adherence to Specifications
(Poster Sizes: 8.5x11, 11x17, or 22x28)
20 points
- Originality and Organization
30 points
- Use of Color and Design
20 points



Presentation of Awards:

First, second, and third place winners at each level will be notified no later than March 30, 2020. The overall, top winning poster will be announced at the National Conference on Magnet Schools in Clark County, Nevada April 13-17, 2020.

Winners will receive a certificate and prize. The National Winning Poster will be proudly displayed in the MSA National Office as well as published in MSA materials.
