

#### NOTE:

- **Institution/School** members may submit one poster to MSA representing the appropriate level elementary, middle, or high.
- \*District members may submit only one poster representing each level elementary, middle, and/or high. Schools should coordinate with their appropriate district level department(s).
  - Each district will determine the posters sent to be judged at the national level.
  - Entries will be accepted from the district level completed by individual students only.
  - All entries will become the property of MSA and will not be returned.
  - Each poster must include the official MSA entry form attached to the back of the poster.

### Deadline for Submitting Posters: Thursday, January 20, 2022

Please complete the online submission <u>form</u> and be prepared to upload a digital copy (minimum resolution: 300dpi) of the poster; <u>for district members\*</u>: a <u>district designee must submit</u>; **AND** 

The original poster(s) must be mailed and RECEIVED in the National Office by Thursday, January 20, 2022 to be eligible. Make sure a copy of the completed form is included with the original poster.

# **Scoring Rubric:**

MSA suggests that school-wide and/or district-wide competitions implement the same scoring rubric for the selection of their winners.

- Adherence to Pillar(s)/Theme(s)
   30 points
- Adherence to Specifications (Poster Sizes: 8.5x11, 11x17, or 22x28)
   20 points
- Originality and Organization
   30 points
- Use of Color and Design 20 points



## **Presentation of Awards:**

First, second, and third place winners at each level will be notified no later than March 31, 2022. The overall, top winning poster will be announced at the National Conference of Magnet Schools in Clark County, Nevada April 18-22, 2022.
