#### February 18-24: Virtual Engagement

Engaging with the community and federal, state, and local elected officials is key to advocating for magnet schools. Are you sharing insight and information about your magnet programs? Use this week to reach out to your elected officials to make them more aware of magnet schools.

#### February 25-29: Appreciation Week
